SPARFELL is proud to announce the launch of its enhanced Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) program, with a specific emphasis on sustainability. The main CSR project, called FLY4WATER, kick-started in Madagascar in April 2023, marking a significant milestone in SPARFELL's commitment to making a positive impact on communities and the environment.



In collaboration with Waves for Water, SPARFELL has implemented its own program to address the critical issue of clean water access in Madagascar. Access to clean and safe drinking water is a fundamental human right, yet millions of people around the world still lack this basic necessity. FLY4WATER aims to provide immediate access to clean water through a filter solution. These filters are designed to remove harmful contaminants and bacteria from water sources, thereby improving

overall health and well-being. The pilot program was successfully launched in Tolaria, Madagascar, positively impacting 12,000 people across nine locations with the distribution of 500 filters. Each filter has the capacity to purify up to one million gallons of water and instantly remove 99.9% of bacteria.

"We are excited to collaborate with Waves for Water and take a proactive approach to address the global water crisis," said Noémie Rosenthal, CSR Director at SPARFELL. "By focusing on clean water access, our FLY4WATER program will make a tangible difference in the lives of those in need, improving health outcomes and fostering sustainable development."

In addition to the FLY4WATER initiative, SPARFELL has achieved significant milestones in its commitment to sustainability. The company has obtained approvals from Austro Control and the Maltese Authority to operate paperless for its Austrian and Maltese AOCs (Air Operator Certificates) through the launch of its Electronic Flight Bag (EFB). This innovative approach replaces all printed documents on board SPARFELL aircraft with iPads, significantly reducing paper usage and weight. By eliminating approximately 25kg of paper per aircraft, SPARFELL not only contributes to environmental conservation but also enhances operational efficiency and reduces fuel consumption.

Furthermore, SPARFELL is demonstrating its support for the Africa Amini Alama organisation in Tanzania. The company is donating laptops and additional funds to improve the teaching standards and classrooms of the Simba Vision English Medium Academy. SPARFELL recognises education as a vital pillar for building sustainable futures for communities, and the Africa Amini Alama organization plays a crucial role in implementing social, educational, and medical projects.
